

Summary of Practical Guideline for Entry to Thailand



For Foreign Students/Staff

01

Presenting a health certificate

02

For students
Presenting confirmation of enrollment (COE)
(issued by the Office of the Registrar)

03

For staff
Presenting contract or invitation letter

04

Presenting health insurance
(a minimum of 100,000 USD and covering the COVID-19)
(paid by the student/staff)

05

Filling out the T8 Form or the AOT Airport of Thailand Application



06

Subject to isolation, quarantine, under observation, or any other measures for the prevention and control of communicable diseases (14 days)



Remark: When applying for a visa, students/staff will be provided with a list of the hotels authorized as State Quarantine & Alternative State Quarantine and a flight by the Royal Thai Embassy. They are required to pay for all the expenses incurred.

For Thai Students/Staff

01

Presenting a health certificate (Fit to Fly)

02

Letter issued by the Royal Thai Embassy certifying that the students/staff are Thai nationals returning to Thailand

03

Filling out the T8 Form or the AOT Airport of Thailand Application

04

Subject to isolation, quarantine, under observation, or any other measures for the prevention and control of communicable diseases



Remark: When applying for a visa, students/staff will be provided with a list of the hotels authorized as State Quarantine & Alternative State Quarantine and a flight by the Royal Thai Embassy. They are required to pay for all the expenses incurred.
